**Champagne Lanson**  
House established 1760 by François Delamotte, a magistrate in Reims – it was the third Champagne House created. Lanson's non-malolactic style has been under command of Jean-Paul Gandon since 1986 when he started as a Chef de Cave.

Lanson Père & Fills, AC Champagne  
"If there is one Non-Vintage Brut Champagne that is universally appreciated, it is surely Lanson Black Label, a great classic with a fresh and elegant style."

**Champagne Lanson White Label** 121,90 €  
Lanson Père & Fills, AC Champagne  
"This champagne was specially created by Jean-Paul Gandon, the Wine-Maker of Lanson for the last 25 years. The blend allows one to appreciate the natural aromas of the champagne, yet enjoying its role of enhancing the aromas"

**Champagne Lanson Gold Label vintage** 146 €  
Lanson Père & Fills, AC Champagne  
"Blend of Chardonnay (49%) and Pinot Noir (51%) that is produced in only the best years and from the best grapes from the best vineyards, Gold Label offers the ultimate expression of a single great year."

**Lanson Extra Age** 149,50 €  
Lanson Père & Fills, AC Champagne  
"In order to maintain a style that combines both complexity and freshness, Lanson combines the outstanding characters of several vintages in this blend of Chardonnay: (40%), and Pinot Noir (60%) from the crus of Chouilly, Avize, Oger, Vertus, Verzenay and Bouzy. Extra Age is aged for a minimum of 5 years."

**Taittinger Comtes de Champagne Blanc de Blanc Vintage 1999** 562,5€

"As a tribute to the Counts of Champagne who ruled over the Saint-Nicaise Abbey and to Thibault IV in particular whose seal marks each bottle, Champagne Taittinger created its most rare and precious cuvee in 1952-the Comtes de Champagne Blanc de Blancs. This blend is pure Chardonnay.

"Carefully blended to age for a minimum of four years on the lees. Slightly dominated by Chardonnay. Associated with some of finest Pinot Noir & Pinot Meunier"

**Champagne de Castelnau Rosé Brut** 109,40 €  
"This Rosé champagne is blend of champagne varieties and small amount of blended Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier red wine"

**Champagne Tsarine Cuvée Premium** 116 €  
Champagne Chanoine Freres, AC Champagne  
"The Chanoine family is one of the oldest in Épernay. In 1730, during the reign of Louis XV, the brothers Jacques-Louis and Jean-Baptiste Chanoine established a company trading in the wines of champagne under the name of Chanoine Frères."

DEEP: a maturation of more than 3 years in Gallo-Roman chalk cellars. A golden champagne, with persistent effervescence. A nose that is both complex and delicious.



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## SPARKLING WINES

### Freixenet S.A

Freixenet was Pedro Ferrer's nickname as the youngest son of the owners of "La Freixeneda" wine-growing estate.

Today Freixenet is run by Pedro's children and grandchildren. The company has kept its focus on high quality despite the huge growth the company has experienced from its humble beginnings in Sant Sadurní 1830 to becoming the Number 1 Sparkling Wine in the World.

### Freixenet Carta Nevada Semi-Seco 40,60 €

Freixenet S.A., Catalunya

"A classic Cava created from an equal proportion of Macabeo, Xarel·lo and Parellada, indigenous to the Penedes region. Aged between 12 and 18 months"

### Freixenet Vintage Reserva Brut 54 €

Freixenet S.A., Catalunya

"A high quality Cava, made only from the first run juice of Xarel·lo and Parellada grapes. Aged depending on the vintage from 18 to 24 months in the cellars."

### Freixenet Legero (non-alkoholic) 9,5 € [20cl]

Freixenet S.A., Catalunya

"De-Alcoholized sparkling wine. Made from Moscatel grape"

## OTHER FINE SPARKLING WINES

### Segura Viudas Lavit Brut Nature 62 €

Segura Viudas, DO Cava, Catalunya, Spain

"The Segura Viudas estate has roots dating back to the 11th century. It started as an inhabited watchtower, and was later converted into a Catalan country house in the 13th century, growing all kinds of crops for the local monastery, including wine grapes. Every bottle of Segura Viudas embodies our effort to reflect the true nature of the *terroir* of the Penedès."

### Sgajo Prosecco Extra Dry 62 €

Perlage, DOC Prosecco Treviso, Italy

"Sgajo means smart and exuberant. This organic wine is also a vegan product: it is produced without any animal protein, normally used during clarification"

### Crémant d'Alsace Arthur Metz Brut Millésimé 65,50 €

Arthur Metz, AC Crémant d'Alsace, France

"Pinot Blanc blend from the Alsace vineyards located at the foot of the Vosges Mountains. Arthur Metz sparkling wines boast a grand finesse and extreme elegance with their fruity freshness and delicate effervescence"

### Klosterneuburg Mathäi Brut 68,10 €

Weingut Stift Klosterneuburg, Niederosterreich, Wagram, Austria

"The Grüner Veltliner grapes used to make this vintage sparkling wine enjoy the best possible conditions for achieving optimum ripeness at the Monastery Wine Estate's sites in Lower Austria. Only wine from the first pressing is used to make Mathäi Brut that is made with champagne method".

### Gloria Ferrer Sonoma Brut 75 €

Gloria Ferrer Vineyards, Sonoma, CA, USA

"Sparkling wine from California, Méthode Traditionnelle style is giving long and soft taste on palate. Fermented in bottle and also a blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir".

### Mistinguet Cava Brut Rose 45 €

Vallformosa, Penedes, Spain

"Rose Cava from Penedes area northern Spain. Deep colour and lot of berry notes, strawberries and raspberries. Stylish and well balanced cava".



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## WHITE WINES FROM EUROPE

### FRANCE

#### **Arthur Metz Gewürztraminer 59 €**

Arthur Metz, AC Alsace

"Arthur Metz was established 1904 and is today one of the leading cremant houses. This wine is off-dry"

#### **Arthur Metz Riesling Grand Cru Steinklotz 68,50 €**

Arthur Metz, AC Alsace Grand Cru

"One of Alsace's 51 Grand Crus. The wine is typical Alsace Gran Cru riesling and perfect combination for Skandinavian flavours"

#### **Château Tour Chapoux 2014 69 €**

Château Tour Chapoux, AC Entre-Deux-Mers

"Château Tour Chapoux hails from Saint Antoine du Queyret, right in the heart of the Entre Deux Mers. The Château is owned by the Comin family who have been there since 1884. The Knights of St John of Jerusalem founded a Commandery at Saint Antoine du Queyret in the early 13th century. These soldier monks were also fine connoisseurs of wine and it is assumed that they chose to grow vines there due to the quality of the area."

#### **Muscadet sévre et Maine 50 €**

Chateau du Cléray AOP

"Château du Cléray have 30 hectares of vineyards which stand on the characteristic sandy soils of the commune of Vallet. The estate has been run by the Sauvion family since 1935, and is today run by winemaker Pierre Sauvion, graduate in oenology at Bordeaux University."

#### **Sancerre Pauline Cuvee de Prestige 2012 85 €**

Les Celliers de la Pauline À Thavenay-En-Sancerroirs, AOP Sancerre

"Style of this Sancerre is pure Sauvignon Blanc, aged in Acacia fûts for 10 months. Fresh, acidic and fresh taste. Surrounded with a soft touch of barrel aging."

#### **Domaine Tabordet Pouilly-Fumé le Champ des Vignes**

Domaine Tabordet, AOC Pouilly-Fumé 75 €

"Characteristic flinty nose and palate opening out to show floral and dried fruit scents with notes of kiwi, melon and rhubarb. Good weight, full bodied with balanced acidity through to a dry and citrus zesty finish."

### GERMANY

#### **RK Weissburgunder 62 €**

Weingut Reichsgraf von Kesselstatt, Mosel

"Winehouse established 1362 by Kuno von Falkenstein. RK is a high-caliber Weissburgunder (Pinot Blanc) cuvée. Its character derives from its origin, the unique vineyards along the Mosel, Saar, and Ruwer"

### AUSTRIA

#### **Stiff Klosterneuburg Riesling 60 €**

Weingut Stift Klosterneuburg, Niederosterreich, Wagram

"The Riesling presents a fresh flavour of peaches, a scent of apricot and a clear structure. The tight composed body is characterized through taste of peaches, balanced acidity and distinctive minerality."

### SPAIN

#### **Pazo de Barrantes Albariño 66,50 €**

Marqués de Murrieta, DO Rías Baixas

"Pazo de Barrantes Estate is located in the Rias Baixas D.O. and it is composed of 12 hectares of albariño vines surrounding the historic property which dates from 1511. An Albariño of great personality, with a striking and fragrant varietal character and surprising bottle ageing potential."

### ITALY

#### **Romio Pinot Grigio 54 €**

Cavio Sca, Grave Friuli DOC

"This light and refreshingly dry Pinot Grigio from the Grave zone of the northernmost region of Italy, Friuli, has beautiful apple and sweet pear aromas on the nose and a velvety, perfectly balanced texture."



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## WHITE WINES FROM NEW WORLD

### ARGENTINA

**Alamos Chardonnay** 39 €  
Catena Zapata, Mendoza  
"Grapes for the Alamos wines are sourced from high altitude 900 – 1500 meters. Cooler nights give better acidity and more synchronised ripeness to the grapes."

### AUSTRALIA

**Yalumba Eden Valley Roussanne** 71,50 €  
Yalumba Winery, South Australia / Eden Valley  
Since 1980's the winemaking team have been keen to work with the perfumed and exotic variety originating in the Northern Rhône, Roussanne. Using their experience with Viognier and other varieties of Rhône origin, the Barossa and specifically the Eden Valley was the natural place to plant.

**Yalumba The Y Series Barossa Riesling 2016** 42,80 €  
Yalumba Winery, South Australia / Eden Valley  
"Delicate orange blossom and citrus fragrances complement refreshing flavours of lemonade. Wild ferment and vegan friendly".

**Lalaland Pinot Grigio 2016** 66,50 €  
Wingara Wine Group, Australia  
"Pinot Grigio from Australia, flavours of fresh pear, white peach and citrus notes".

**Chemin des Sables Rose** 53,50 €  
Les Grands Chais de France, Languedoc-Roussillon, VdP d'Oc, VdP de l'Aude

### NEW ZEALAND

**Sileni The Lodge Chardonnay 2015** 65,50 €  
Sileni Estates, Hawke's Bay  
"Ripe stonefruit and citrus, with subtle barrel ferment and toasted almond flavours. A subtle background of almonds and toast make up a wine which is sophisticated."

### SOUTH AFRICA

**Spier Discover medium sweet** 41 €  
Spier Wine Farm, Stellenbosch  
"One of Spier Cape's oldest wine houses. The wine estate has cultivated grapes from 1692 and the vines were planted among the first six in African soil. In 1712 the first harvest was picked."

**Franschoek Cellar La Cotte Mill Chenin Blanc 2016** 62 €  
Franschoek Cellar, Franschoek  
"This rich and complex wine is perfect with fish dishes and white meat dishes allso. Chenin Blanc with pineapple, peach, nectarine and honeysuckle aromas."



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## RED WINES FROM EUROPE

### AUSTRIA

**Klosterneuburg St Laurent Ausstich 70 €**  
Weingut Stift Klosterneuburg, Niederösterreich, Wagram  
"Since its foundation in 1114 Klosterneuburg monastery has been growing wine and therefore is the oldest wine estate of Austria."

### FRANCE

**Château de Fesles**  
**Cabernet Franc La Chapelle Vieilles Vignes 53,50 €**  
Château de Fesles, AC Anjou  
"The Château de Fesles is certainly one of the oldest properties in the region. Situated at the heart of the Coteaux de Layon, this family-owned property enjoys an international reputation. In this vineyard where the Chenin is king, Bernard Germain produces marvellous sweet wines (Bonnezeaux)."

**Guigal Côtes-du-Rhône Rouge 60 €**  
Guigal, AC Côtes-du-Rhône  
"Legendary producer who played a pioneering role in improving north Rhône's international reputation."

**Château Le Bourdieu 2011 79 €**  
Château Le Bourdieu, AC Médoc  
"Le Bourdieu is situated in Médoc, near the village of Valeyrac, in one of the great wine growing regions of France. Built circa 1830 by Philippe Delacourt, Lord of Bourdieu."

**Maranges 79,50 €**  
Nuiton-Beaunoy, AC Maranges  
"This Pinot Noir comes from 60 years old vineyards located in village of Cheilly les Marranges –at the southern part of Côte de Beaune."

**Willm Alsace Pinot Noir Cuvée Emile Willm 2013 79 €**  
Willm, AOC Alsace  
"This wine, aged in oak barrels is entirely made from Pinot Noir grapes coming from selected limestone soils. Fruity and soft Pinot Noir."

### ITALY

**Amarone Classico Riserva 101 €**  
Gerardo Cesari, DOC Amarone della Valpolicella  
"Produced in the boroughs of Negrar, Marano di Valpolicella, Sant'Ambrogio, Fumane, San Pietro in Cariano (the historic area of Valpolicella Classico production)."

**Poggio Bonelli Chianti Classico 71,50 €**  
Poggio Bonelli, DOCG Chianti Classico  
"Wine-making traditions from the sixteenth century. The estate, which is owned – together with the Chigi Saracini farms – by Mps Tenimenti SpA, extends over 840 hectares approx., with vineyards covering a surface of 80 ha."

**b.io Primitivo 2015 63 €**  
Agricoa Lugo, IGP Puglia  
"Organic Primitivo from southeast part of Italy. Dark color, fruity and spicy notes. B.io is the environment in balance, where even the tiny insects of our vineyards are an important link in the ecosystem in which we cultivate".

**Ripasso Bosan 2013 93 €**  
Cesari, D.O.C. Valpolicella Ripasso  
"Delicious "half" dried grapes of Corvina, Molinara and Rondinella. Intense, ruby deep color".

**Cantine Leonardo da Vinci Brunello Di Montalcino 101 €**  
Cantine Leonardo da Vinci, Brunello di Montalcino D.O.C.G.  
"Maceration takes place on the lees: fermentation lasts approximately 15-20 days, together with gentle and frequent pumping-over. Stainless steel tanks are used for fermentation, pure Sangiovese grapes."



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## RED WINES FROM NEW WORLD

### SPAIN

**Beronia Crianza 46 €**  
Bodegas Beronia, DOCa Rioja  
"In the 3rd century BC the Rioja region was inhabited by the Berones, a warrior people of Celtic origin. In 1973 Bodegas Beronia was founded. Today all the vineyards are specially selected and the grape varieties used are the indigenous ones authorised by the DOCa Rioja – Tempranillo (90%), Graciano (3%) Mazuelo (3%) and Viura (4%)."

**Marqués de Murrieta Reserva 2010 55,50 €**  
Bodegas Marqués de Murrieta DOCa Rioja  
"Murrieta Reserva is matured 21 months in American oak barrels. Full of cherry and spicy aromas."

**Marques de Cáceres Gran Reserva 2008 95 €**  
Bodegas Marques de Cáceres, DOCa Rioja  
"Grand Reserva wines are produced only on exceptional years. This blend of Tempranillo, Graciano and Garnacha has spent minimum of 28 months in French oak and 4 years in the bottle."

**Susana (Sempre...) roble 2015 53,50 €**  
Santa María del Camí, Vi de la Terra Mallorca, Balears – Sin D.O.  
"This red wine is produced by Freixenet group but the grapes are coming from island of Mallorca. Round and soft blend of three different grapes Manto Negro, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot."

### PORTUGAL

**Adega de Pegões Touriga nacional 58 €**  
Adega de Pegões, Vinho Regional Peninsula de Setúbal  
"Adega de Pegões Touriga Nacional is an award-winning Adega de Pegões cooperative produced wine. It is produced in the Setúbal peninsula south of Lisbon where the Atlantic cooling effect helps the grapes to develop intense aromas."

### AUSTRALIA

**The Signature 119 €**  
Yalumba Winery, South Australia/Barossa Valley  
"The Signature -wine was prepared for the first time in 1962. Made from Cabernet Sauvignon & Shiraz. Deep, complex and brooding, The Signature is a cerebral wine crafted with longevity in mind."

**Yalumba Y Series Shiraz Viognier 2014 44,40 €**  
Yalumba, South Australia  
"This Shiraz Viognier is a smooth, juicy, fruity wine. This blend of two varieties was originally from the Northern Rhone. A little of the white grape Viognier softens Shiraz and adds an aromatic lift."

### ARGENTINA

**Navarro Correas Reserva Malbec 78,80 €**  
Navarro Correas, Mendoza  
"Mendoza is by far the largest wine region in Argentina. Located on a high-altitude plateau at the edge of the Andes Mountains, the province is responsible for roughly 70 percent of the country's annual wine production."

### CHILE

**Casa Silva Colección Cabernet Sauvignon 43 €**  
Viña Casa Silva, Colchagua Valley  
"Vineyard in the Colchagua Valley was founded by French wine pioneer Emilio Bouchon in 1892. Now his legacy will continue to Mario Silva and his family. The company produces unique and personalized wines. Many of the nearly one hundred years old vines are imported from Bordeaux."

**Santa Helena Chile Merlot 185 €**  
Santa Helena, Central Valley  
"Ripe aromas that recall fresh black fruit, such as blackberries. Good intensity, clean, young on palate"

### LEBANON

**Chateau Musar 2009 91 €**  
Chateau Musar, Bekaa Valley  
"Chateau Musar is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Carignan and Cinsault. Musar is dense and richly textured with intense "Baked fruitiness. Organic wine which has been matured total of 7 years"



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#### UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

**Gloria Ferrer Carneros Pinot Noir 90 €**

Gloria Ferrer Caves & Vineyards, Carneros AVA

“Eleven soil types and a variety of Pinot Noir clones and selections, varied terrain plus the daily effects of cooling summer breezes and morning fog combine to produce exceptional wine from our 335 acre estate vines in Carneros . As our understanding and development of our terroir grows, our estate Pinot Noir gains complexity and consistency.”

#### SOUTH AFRICA

**Franschhoek Cellar The Stone Bridge Pinotage 63 €**

Franschhoek Cellar, Franschhoek

“Dark garnet with a bright purple rim. Generous aromas of black cherries, clove and raspberry leading to a smooth and juicy palate with redolent ripe mulberries and glimmers of spice from gentle oaking. Finishes with appealing length and savouriness.”
